CONTENT AND STRUCTURE

Administrative/Biographical History:

Euphemia Marie Peterson was born March 1, 1881 in Varna, Illinois to Swedish immigrant parents, August and Sophia Peterson. In 1883, the family moved just north of Bertrand, Nebraska where they farmed. She studied at Bertrand High School and at the Luther Academy in Wahoo, Nebraska. She graduated from Augustana Hospital School of Nursing in Chicago (also referred to as Augustana Hospital Training School for Nurses) in 1911.

Euphemia worked as a nurse with the telephone company in Chicago before working as a public health nurse in Nebraska and Iowa. As a public health nurse, she inspected rural schoolchildren's health and dental hygiene. Later she was employed as nurse and nurses' supervisor at Moline Lutheran Hospital, Moline, Illinois. She also worked for the Nebraska Tuberculosis Association and Iowa Tuberculosis Association for many years. Her scrapbook contains many newspaper clippings noting her various achievements in rural public health and school health inspections.

Euphemia married John F. Stewart in 1934, when she was 53 years old. The couple resided in Chicago Illinois. John died in 1939. Euphemia married Pastor D. Verner Swanson in 1950 in Moline, Illinois. The couple lived for many years in Geneva, Illinois, where he was a Pastor, before retiring to Rochester, Minnesota where she passed away on July 7, 1974. She is buried in Immanuel Cemetery in Bertrand, Nebraska.

Scope and Content:

Collection of materials from Euphemia Peterson's nursing career. Peterson graduated from Augustana Hospital Training School in Chicago in 1911 and received additional training in public health nursing at

the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis. She was a registered nurse in Illinois, Iowa, and Nebraska. This collection includes newspaper clippings related to her nursing career and public health concerns at the time (1910s-1930s), nursing correspondence and certificates, registration cards in local and national nursing associations, a school photograph of Euphemia in nursing uniform, and a nurse's cap.
