### **Biographical Sketch**

Henry Granat served as President of the American Union of Swedish Singers (A.U.S.S) from 1970-1974. He was born on February 2, 1918 in Portland, Oregon to John Rickard and Ellen Elizabeth (Lindblad), of

Lyrestad, Västergötland. Granat received a degree in Forestry from Oregon State University in 1944. In 1949, he married Louise Staats. Together they had 5 children.

Granat joined the Portland Swedish Male Chorus in 1945 and subsequently served as the group's treasurer, secretary and president. He served as president of the A.U.S.S. Western Division from 1965-1969.

## **Content/Description**

This collection contains organizational notes, correspondence, convention programs, convention song books, scores of music, and photographs from various choruses who were members of the American Union of Swedish Singers.

# Arrangement

Series I: Minutes, Reports and Organizational Records. Arranged chronologically by start date and divided by chorus. Contains bound volumes and loose papers documenting meeting minutes of various choruses from 1917–1990.

Series II: Conventions, Tours, Singing festivals, and Concerts. Arranged chronologically. Contains bound programs and song albums as well as loose notes and miscellaneous paperwork on conventions.

Series III: Financial Records. Arranged first by chorus then chronologically. Contains bound ledgers and loose paper document financial records.

Series IV: Correspondence (Henry Granat, C.A. Appelgren, and Ladies Auxiliary). Arranged by recipient and then by creator. Contains loose documents including letters, envelopes, and paper correspondence.

Series V: Photographs. Unsorted. Contains one large [broken into five pieces] photograph of the United Swedish Singers of the Pacific Coast, Singing Festival in San Francisco and Oakland, June 16–24, 1915 and unsorted photographs that were unlabeled and undated.

Series VI: Scores of Music. Unsorted. Contains sheet music and lyric sheets, both in Swedish (bulk) and in English.
