Donated to the Swenson Center by Nancy Lofgren in 2013. Bengt Lofgren was Nancy Lofgren's Great Uncle. The materials were kept in the home of Astrid and Irving Norgren until their death.

Biographical Sketch

Justina Karlsson was born on June 1, 1878 in Dalsland. Her father was Karl Johan Jacobson (b. 1823-10-04 d. 1910-07-09) of Synneröd, Hede socken i Bohuslän. Her mother was Märta Lisa Johansdotter (b. 1838-08-18 d. 1882-04-24). Justina married Bengt Löfgren on March 12, 1902.

Bengt Jönson Löfgren (in America, he sometimes went by Benjamin) was born February 16, 1873 to Jöns Lövgren and Pernilla Svensson-Lövgren in Lörby, Lister-Mjällby, Sweden (near Sölvesborg in the province of Blekinge). In 1892, at the age of 19, he took his first trip to the U.S. where he stayed for 5

years before heading back to Sweden. In Sweden, he met Justina, who had also been to the U.S. In 1902, they were married and back in the United States living in New York City and the Dunellen, New Jersey area.

Justina and Bengt had 6 children, but only 2 survived until adulthood. Oscar (b. 1904-01-16 d. 1913-07-07) died after being bitten by a rabid dog outside the family home. He was the first child to receive the new rabies vaccine and it appeared to work for a time, but he died about a month after receiving the vaccine. Hjalmar (b. 1906-04-07 d. 1969-04-12) married Inez Johansson from Stockholm on 1937-10-07 in the Gustav Adolf church in New York City. They had no children. Thor (b. 1907-10-19 d. 1910-12-31) was the Lofgren's third child. Astrid (b. 1909-10-28 d. 1981-05-29) married Irving Norgren of Brooklyn on 1946-09-14 in Gustav Adolf church in New York City. They had no children. Ragnar (b. 1911-10-21 d. 1919-10-11) died as a child of "brain fever." Vivian (b. 1914-05-24 d. 1914-05-26) only survived two days.

Hjalmar worked in a bank. Astrid graduated from Hunter College and worked for the Swedish American Line with Hjalmar's wife, Inez. The Lofgren family maintained close contact with their family back in Sweden. They returned to Sweden to visit several times (via the Swedish American Line). Justina kept journals of these trips and took many photographs.

Bengt Lofgren died Aug. 12, 1956 at the age of 83 after becoming ill with heart problems. Justina died September 26, 1967 at 89. In her final years, she had been a resident at the Augustana Home for the Aged in Brooklyn, New York after suffering a broken hip while on a cruise with Hjalmar and Inez.

Content/Description

This collection documents the history of an immigrant family's life in New York City from 1902 to the 1960s. Of particular note are the diaries and description of the first years in the United States from 1891-1898 and the families' return trips to Sweden in the 1950s, mostly written by Justina Lofgren.
