

Disclosures Related to Written Arrangements

Augustana College, a 4 year undergraduate degree granting institution, has written cooperation agreements with the following institutions whereby a portion of a student's educational program can be completed while studying abroad.

Botswana: University of Botswana in Gaborone

A 15,000 student campus of the national university in southern Africa is the site of this semester-long exchange program. Augustana students can study in several Liberal Arts fields while living in student residences in the nation's capital. Augustana students can complete approximately 12% to 15% of their educational program through the U. of Botswana. Students shall pay current tuition and other mandatory academic fees, including room and board, to Augustana. Additional costs to students include, but are not limited to, transportation to and from Botswana; miscellaneous living expenses; passport expenses; residence permit/visa expenses; excess baggage shipment and storage; independent travel; and such personal expenses as telephone charges, textbooks, etc.

Hong Kong: Lingnan University

Lingnan in Hong Kong is a 2,300 student Liberal Arts program quite similar to Augustana's. Lingnan offers a varied curriculum as well as a diverse, international student body. Coursework is completed in English with the option to take courses in Chinese language. Augustana students can complete up to 25% of their educational program through Lingnan University. Participating students pay current tuition, other mandatory fees, and room charges to Augustana. They pay any miscellaneous fees to Lingnan University. Additional cost to students include, but are not limited to, meals; miscellaneous living expenses; transportation to and from Hong Kong; independent travel; passport and immigration expenses; excess luggage expense; telephone charges; textbooks; etc.

Germany: The Catholic University of Eichstatt-Ingolstadt

Eichstatt is a beautiful small town located in the heart the scenic Bavarian region of southern Germany. Augustana students who have completed German 308 are eligible to study for one or two semesters at the University of Eichstatt where they study side-by-side with native Germans. Students can complete up to 25% of their educational program through the University of Eichstatt. . Participating students pay current tuition at Augustana. They are responsible for paying room and board and the student service fee while at the University of Eichstatt. Additional costs to students include, but are not limited to, textbooks; transportation; and health care not covered in fees

Germany: The University of Passau

Passau is located in eastern Bavaria on the German-Austrian border. Augustana students who have completed German 308 are eligible to study for one or two semesters at the University of Passau where they study side-by-side with native Germans. Students with no prior experience in German may still apply for the program as there are many courses offered in English as well as introductory German classes. Students can complete up to 25% of their educational program through the University of Passau. Participating students pay current tuition at Augustana. Student housing will be provided by the University of Passau for up to ten months at no cost. Augustana students are responsible for paying board and the student fee. Additional costs to students include, but are not limited to, textbooks; transportation; accommodations outside of term; and health care not covered in fees.

Germany: The University of Regensburg

Regensburg is located in eastern Bavaria. Augustana students who have completed German 308 are eligible to study for one or two semesters at the University of Regensburg where they study side-by-side with native Germans. Students can complete up to 25% of their educational program through the University of Regensburg. Participating students pay current tuition at Augustana. They are responsible for paying room and board and the student service fee while at the University of Regensburg. Additional costs to students include, but are not limited to, textbooks; transportation; and health care not covered in fees

Sweden: Uppsala University

Uppsala University is Sweden's most prestigious institution of higher learning. The opportunity to study at Uppsala is open to any academic major and highly recommended for students in Scandinavian Studies. Coursework is available in both English and Swedish. Students may opt for a semester or a full-year experience, therefore students can complete up to 25% of their educational program through Uppsala University. Participating students pay current tuition and required fees to Augustana. Participating students are financially responsible for accommodation expenses (room & board). Additional cost to students include, but are not limited to, transportation to and from Uppsala University, medical insurance and/or medical expenses; insurance covering travel and personal liabilities incurred while not on the university campus; textbooks and miscellaneous personal expenses; passport and visa costs; and all other debts incurred during the course of the year.

Japan: Kobe City University of Foreign Studies

KCUFS in Kobe, Japan is a school of similar size to Augustana offering a varied program of study to students across the globe. Students must have completed at least Japanese 103 to be eligible for this intensive Japanese language program. Students on this program may study for one or two semesters depending on their needs and on the policies of the home institution (Augustana), therefore students can complete up to 25% of their educational program at the university. Participating students pay current tuition and required fees to Augustana. Students are financially responsible for room and board costs while attending Kobe. Additional cost to students include, but are not limited to, purchase of University or National Health Insurance plans once in Japan; all travel costs to and from Japan, including costs of securing passport and visa; textbooks and miscellaneous personal expenses; and independent travel.
