


Configuring Windows 7 for the Augustana Wireless Network

Follow these instructions to connect a Windows 7 computer to the Augustana wireless network.

1. Click the Windows (Start) button and then click **Control Panel**.
2. Click **Network and Internet** and then click **Network and Sharing Center**.
3. Click **Manage wireless networks**.



4. Click **Add** and then click **Manually create a network profile**.




5. Enter the following information:

Network name: "AugustanaWiFi(Secured)"

Security type: "WPA2-Enterprise"

Encryption type: "AES"



6. Click Next and then click **Change connection settings**.
7. Click on the **Security** tab.



- Uncheck **Validate server certificate**.




- Click the **Configure...** button.
- Uncheck **Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any)**.




- Click **OK** and then click **OK** again.
- Click **Advanced settings**.

14. Check **Specify authentication mode:** and select **User authentication**.



15. Click **OK**.

Note: If you want Windows to remember your username and password, check the box next to "Remember my credentials for this connection each time I'm logged on". Note: After you change your Augustana password, you will be prompted to enter your username and new password when you connect to the wireless network.




16. Click **OK**, and then click **Close**.

17. Click on the wireless network icon in the system tray (in the lower-right corner of the screen).



18. Click **Augustana** and then click **Connect**.



19. Enter your username and password when prompted and click **OK**.



20. You will be connected to the Augustana wireless network.
