

Communication Studies Major for the 2016 Cohort Graduating in 2020

In general, this means you entered in the Fall of 2016. If you make normal academic progress, only your senior year will be on semesters.

In order to complete the major, you will need to complete 28 COMM credits; that's the same under both systems. As part of those 28 credits, you will need to complete at least one 3 or 4 cr. COMM skills course, two gateway courses (either 3 or 4 cr.), one theory course (either 3 or 4 cr.), and a Senior Inquiry project (4 cr., though you may substitute a second theory course if you complete your SI in another major and enough elective credits to reach the 28 credit total). **You do not** need to complete the requirement of three 1-credit research modules. Any research modules you do take will count as elective credit.

Your goal should be (1) to complete at least 20 COMM credits and (2) your skills/gateway/theory requirement by the end of your junior year. Use this form to plan the rest of your major courses.
