Within these credits, ideally you will complete as a sophomore the three-course reporting sequence - 250, 251, 252 (3 cr./course); Media Literacy (3 cr.); Politics (MJMC-211) or Advertising (MJMC-212) (3 cr.); as a junior Media Theory (3 cr.); Law & Ethics (3 cr.); sometime between or during junior and senior years a major internship; and as a senior your SI courses (2 cr.) and any remaining electives needed to meet 30 credits.
