## <u>Communication Studies Major for the Cohort Graduating in 2022</u>

For those entering Augie in Fall of 2018, if you make normal academic progress, your sophomore, junior, and senior years will be on semesters.

In order to complete the major, you will need to complete 28 COMM credits; that's the same under both systems. As part of those 28 credits, you will need to complete one 3- or 4-credit skills course and a follow-up 2-credit skills module, two gateway courses (3 or 4 cr. each), one theory course (4 cr.), and a Senior Inquiry project (4 cr., though you may substitute a second theory course if you complete your SI in another major and enough elective credits to reach the 28 credit total).

Nothing is specifically required in your first year at Augie. Suggested starting courses include COMM 104 (101 under semesters) and/or any of the gateway courses.
