Space is limited. A \$100.00 deposit MUST accompany this registration form to secure a spot. This deposit will be applied toward your clinic fee, but will NOT be refunded should you choose not to attend the summer session. We will try to accommodate each client's preferences. Final decisions will be made according to individual needs and clinicians' schedules. You will be contacted when scheduling is complete.

To finalize registration, a current IEP and progress report or a current assessment from a licensed or certified SLP must be delivered to the Center by May 28th. If reports are not received by this date, your name will be removed from the summer waiting list, and your deposit will not be refunded. If reports are not available, testing at the Center will be required to determine eligibility and to identify goals. Testing will take 1-1 ½ hours and will be scheduled during the week of June 4th. The fee for testing is \$200.00. If your child is eligible for services, \$100.00 of the assessment fee will be applied to the summer fee. If your child is not eligible for services, the \$200.00 fee for testing will NOT be refunded. If you want to have your child tested, please check "yes" below and an appointment will be scheduled.
