Courses required for the first year: none

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The Major in Spanish: 3 Tracks

Spanish Major: 32 credits, including 301, 302, two 300-level culture courses (one peninsular and one Latin American), two additional 300-level content courses (one literature and one linguistics), 4 elective credits at 202 or above, and the completion of a Senior Inquiry both written and presented in Spanish.

Spanish for Professional Use Major: 30 credits, including 301, 302, 318 or 319, two 300-level culture courses (one peninsular and one Latin American), two additional 300-level content courses (one literature and one linguistics), and 2 elective credits at 202 or above. The Senior Inquiry is completed within the department of the paired professional major. *Student must have already declared a pre-professional major (see a Spanish program representative for the updated list of approved majors) in order to qualify for this major.*

Spanish Teaching Major: 34 credits, including 301, 302, 311, two 300-level culture courses (one peninsular and one Latin American), two additional 300-level content courses (one literature and one linguistics), 4 elective credits at 202 or above, and the completion of a Senior Inquiry both written and presented in Spanish.
