<b>Courses recommended for the first year:</b> 1- 2xx ENCW class and/or 1 2xx ENGL class
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## The Major in Creative Writing

30 credits, including one 2xx level ENGL class, two 2xx level ENCW classes, three 3xx level ENCW classes, one ENCW or ENGL elective at the 2xx level or higher, a 0-credit internship (may be completed by working one year on Saga, taking ENCW 300: Book Publishing, or completing a community internship with faculty supervision and creative writing faculty approval), and Senior Inquiry (ENCW 490).

Notes: All Creative Writing majors will get a PA by completing the major and will also *likely* earn a PL, PH or PP as part of their major coursework.

### Major Overview

Creative Writing majors pursue a wide range of career paths including marketing, publishing, technical writing, freelance writing, web writing, professional writing, and many, many others.

Creative Writing majors have an internship requirement, which may be fulfilled by completing an internship (e.g., the River Readings internship, publishing internships in New York or Denver, internships at the Midwest Writing Center, Putnam Museum, Quad-Cities Arts, etc.), by working on SAGA, or by taking ENGL 300: Book Publishing. The internship requirement is usually undertaken in students' sophomore, junior, or senior years.

During J-Term, Creative Writing majors may be interested in taking ENCW 300: Literary Residency, wherein they will have the chance to work on a project of their own choosing. Creative Writing students might also be advised to consider the department's (optional) J-Term study away options, offered in Mexico, England, Ireland, and Paris.
