The Major in History

30 credits, distributed as follows: 8 credits from 100 or 200-level history courses; 4 credits for HIST-300; 6 credits for SI sequence (HIST-440 and HIST-450); 12 additional credits at the 300/400 level. At least 4 credits in geographic areas outside the U.S.

Majors may count up to 8 AP/IB (score of 4 or 5) credits towards the major. These students should choose a 100 or 200-level course from an area outside of their AP/IB subject area.

In their sophomore year, students should take HIST-300. History then allows majors to choose 300-level courses from four Compass Points to develop an area of expertise. These include History Communication, Nations and Global Politics, Social Justice, and Information Analytics. After declaring, students should consult with major advisors about which Compass Point matches their goals and interests.
