BSN 2+2 Articulation Agreement

Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences of Rock Island, IL (Trinity"), and **Augustana College** of Rock Island, IL ("Augustana") believe that a cooperative program benefits students by allowing students an opportunity to enroll at both institutions to earn a Bachelor of Science Nursing degree.

This agreement defines the Articulation Agreement between Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences and Augustana College for qualified students seeking to complete their general education coursework at Augustana College and the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) curriculum, Basic Option, at Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences.

Agreement

The Articulation Agreement is designed to provide participating students with a specific pathway to meet degree requirements established by Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences for a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree at Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences. This agreement applies to students who are enrolled at Augustana who are admitted to the 2+2 nursing pathway at Augustana College.

It is agreed and understood that each institution has the right and responsibility to make changes to its curricula and enrollment standards to maintain its academic integrity and meet accreditation standards. Such changes, if any, will be communicated to the other institution as they occur through the office of each institution responsible for implementing this dual degree program.

At the request of either institution, a meeting or conference will be held to resolve any problems and monitor progress under the terms of this Articulation Agreement.

Under the terms of this agreement, neither institution is obligated to make any payments of any kind to the other institution.

Trinity will provide or support a nursing advisor or coordinator who would be available for weekly in person or remote "office hours."

For students completing a baccalaureate degree at Augustana College, please see the Articulation Agreement that applies: BA/BSN Dual Degree Articulation Agreement, BA/MSN Dual Degree Articulation Agreement.

For high school students seeking early acceptance to the BSN program, please see BSN EDGE Articulation Agreement.

Academic Requirements for students wishing to complete General Education Requirements at Augustana before completing the BSN at Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences.

1. The student must complete the required general education courses for the BSN degree Basic Option at Augustana College to be accepted as transfer credits to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree, Basic Option, at Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences.
2. The following general education courses must be completed prior to the BSN curriculum at Trinity.

Year 1:

- FYI 100 and 1 First Year Writing course (English Composition I) *Fall course
- SOAN 101: Introduction to Sociology (Sociology)
- CHEM 215: Molecular Nutrition (Nutrition)
- MATH 130: Statistics for Health Professionals (Statistics)
- SOAN 102: Introduction to Anthropology (Anthropology)
- PSYC 100: Introduction to Psychology (Psychology)
- BIOL 251: Anatomy & Physiology (Anatomy and Physiology I) *Fall course
- BIOL 252 Human Physiology (Anatomy and Physiology II) *Spring course

Year 2:

- COMM 101 Public Speaking (Oral Communication)
- PSYC 216 Human Development (Human Growth and Development)
- BIOL 171: Microbiology (Microbiology with lab)
- PHIL 103, RELG 355 or PHIL 312 Social Ethics (Ethics)
- DISA200, HIST 33, MEDH 200, PHIL 105, RELG 263, RELG 370, WGSS 130, or WGSS 235(choose one) Humanities Requirement (Humanities)
- CLAS 290 Medical Terminology (Medical Terminology)
- ENGL 292 or DISA 200 Composition II (English Composition II)
- General Elective: Choose from COMM 250, PSYC 226, PUBH 100, PUBH 180, PUBH 306, or SOAN 223 (Meets the Trinity College Algebra requirement, based on language below).

>DISA 200 cannot be used to fulfill both Composition II and Ethics requirement

- Trinity College Algebra requirement: Students entering Augustana will be assigned a Math Index Score based on ACT/SAT Scores and high school coursework. This score must be sufficiently high to gain admittance to Math 130, i.e. testing out of Algebra II. Students will complete 1 general elective

course from the above list to substitute for and satisfy the Algebra entry requirement.

3. The student must achieve a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 for admission to the Trinity BSN degree program. (See Appendix A)

Registration

Pre-Nursing Advisor will complete the application at Trinity College with the student.

Accreditation

Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences and Augustana College will ensure they maintain accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission regional accrediting body and ensure all operations will be in keeping with accreditation requirements of the two institutions.

Duration and Termination of Agreement

Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences and Augustana College agree this Agreement shall be in force the date of the signing of the Agreement and shall remain in force until modified or terminated in writing, following reasonable and mutual discussion by representatives of the two institutions.

Trinity College of Nursing & Health Sciences and Augustana College reserve the right to revise or eliminate programs and courses. Such changes will be communicated to the appropriate parties. This articulation agreement will be reviewed annually to ensure currency with each party's degree requirements and may be modified by attachment.

Either party may terminate this Agreement upon written notice to the Party, with at least 90 days advance notice. In the event of such a termination, any student admitted into the BSN program under this Agreement, will continue to apply the transferred pre-requisite courses and credits to the Trinity BSN program as specified in this Agreement provided the student continues to meet satisfactory progress toward their bachelor's degree.
